

DMVQ PRINTABLE CHECKLIST

License Reinstatement Checklist

Use this to pay Ohio reinstatement fees at an official DMV or BMV office once your suspension's cause is cleared.

Fees here, causes elsewhere


DMVQ collects reinstatement fees. The cause of the suspension is cleared with the court, CSEA, or your insurer first. Paying the fee does not lift an unmet condition.


BRING THESE

Bring to pay your fees

-  **Reinstatement requirements letter**
Or your driving record, so payment is applied to the right suspension.

-  **Photo ID**
Your current photo identification.

-  **Proof the cause is satisfied**
Court entry, proof of insurance or SR-22, or remedial-course completion, if your requirements call for it.

-  **Payment**
Cash, check, money order, or credit card. A \$10 deputy registrar service fee applies to in-person reinstatement payments.

DECISION POINT

Clear the cause first

Court suspension

OVI, points, or failure to appear or pay is satisfied with the court that ordered it.

Insurance suspension

Non-compliance is satisfied through your insurer, who files proof of insurance or an SR-22 as required.

Child-support hold

Handled through the Child Support Enforcement Agency and the court.

AT THE VISIT

Simple steps

- 1** Get your reinstatement requirements letter or driving record from the Ohio BMV.

- 2** Satisfy each cause with the responsible office and collect proof.

- 3** Pay your reinstatement fees at an official DMV or BMV office.

- 4** Confirm every suspension shows satisfied, and renew your license separately if it expired.

Avoid a return trip

Do not pay the fee before clearing the cause. The suspension stays in place.

Do not overlook a second suspension. One unmet hold keeps you off the road.

Do not forget the license itself. Reinstatement and renewal are two separate transactions.
